I. CALL TO ORDER

- A. Roll Call and the Recording of Members Present – Declaration of quorum.
- B. Pledge of Allegiance to the U.S. Flag and Prayer.
- C. Recording of Staff Members Present.

II. ANNOUNCEMENTS AND PUBLIC COMMENTS

- A. Announcements from the Chairman and Appraisal District Office.
- B. Public Comments. Comments are limited to three (3) minutes per speaker. The timekeeper will inform the speaker when they have one (1) remaining minute. No more than three (3) persons will be allowed to speak on any side of an issue. Should there be more than three (3) people who wish to speak on a particular issue, they need to select not more than three (3) representatives to speak for them and the presiding officer may limit the public comments further in the interest of an orderly meeting. Complaints, criticisms and concerns against Appraisal District employees shall be directed through the appropriate channels in accordance with District policy. The presiding officer or designee shall determine whether a person who wishes to address the Board will be addressing an issue that is the subject of a hearing before the Board. If so, the Board may require that the comments be held and presented at the time of the hearing in order to comply with State law.

III. DISCUSSION AND ACTION ITEMS

- A. In accordance with provisions of the Texas Property Tax Code:
 - 1. Hear and determine filed protests on 2019, and prior appraisal years, and/or approve ARB panel recommendations.
 - 2. Hear “good cause” appeals on late filed protests to determine on the merits of the case whether a hearing will be scheduled.
 - 3. Declaration of No Shows.
 - 4. Hear and determine motions to approve supplemental appraisal records, late homestead exemption applications; late applications for agricultural use valuation and appraisal roll error corrections for all appraisal years. Receive supplemental appraisal records for omitted properties submitted for review on all appraisal years.
