

Beginning on Monday, March 30, 2020, the La Salle County Appraisal District will continue operations but will not provide face-to-face services to the public inside the building as part of ongoing efforts to reduce the spread of the COVID-19 virus in the area. The District believes it is in the best interest of our property owners and employees to temporarily suspend direct face-to-face contact with the public while continuing to provide services through other options, such as the phone or email and online services. Forms and applications are available on the District's website at www.lasallecad.com. Social distancing is one of the best ways to support the health of the entire community, which is why the District has also postponed any public workshops until further notice. The La Salle County Appraisal District will continue to have employees available to answer any questions by phone or email during regular business hours, being Monday through Friday, 8:00am to 5:00pm. In addition, as a result of the impact placed on property owners during this time, the Chief Appraiser is granting an automatic deadline extension of thirty (30) days to anyone required to submit applications or rendition statements to the La Salle County Appraisal District office. This extension applies to General Homestead Exemptions, Business Personal Property Renditions and Applications for Agricultural Special Valuation. The extended deadlines are as follows:

- Deadline for Exemption Applications – May 30, 2020
- Deadline for Filing Business Personal Property Renditions – May 15, 2020
- Deadline for Filing Applications for Agricultural Special Valuation – May 30, 2020.
